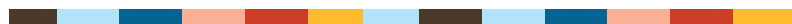


2017: A Year of Monumental Growth



HealthWell's Board, staff and the patients we serve recognize and give thanks to the stakeholders who helped propel us through a year in which we assisted a record number of patients with a record amount of financial support. In fact, 2017 represents the busiest and most impactful year in HealthWell's history. Due to the generosity and continued commitment of our donors, HealthWell received more than **\$358* million** in individual and corporate donations, which allowed us to broaden our funds across a variety of disease areas and increase the number of patients we assisted through our programs.

As a result, we awarded more than **\$353 million to over 88,900 underinsured Americans**, a growth of more than 50,000 patients over any prior year.

Amid increased scrutiny of patient assistance programs (PAPs) in the media and by various government organizations in 2017, we continued to run our programs in full compliance of federal guidance that governs the copayment assistance industry, using the highest ethical standards as the cornerstone of our operations. Our transparency and efficiency were recognized by leading charity watchdog groups and publications such as Charity Navigator, Guidestar, *Forbes*, and the *Chronicle of Philanthropy*.
